

<u>Upcoming Changes to the Certification Exam for INSURANCE program courses:</u>

CURRENT PROGRAM (In effect until February 28, 2023)	NEW PROGRAM (Opt-in for existing students starting January 23, 2023. Required for all students starting February 28, 2023)
Certification based on successful completion of prerequisite learning activities and a single online proctored exam.	Certification based on successful completion of modular online proctored exams.
Single online proctored exam (maximum four attempts).	Modular online proctored exams (maximum four attempts per module).
A grade of 60% or higher is required to pass the exam. Students who are unsuccessful on their fourth attempt must re-enrol into the course.	A grade of 60% or higher is required to pass each modular exam. Students who are unsuccessful on their fourth attempt of any of the modular exams must reenrol into the course.
\$60 exam fee applies to single online proctored exam.	\$12.50 exam fee applies per modular online proctored exam.
Book online into any open timeslot available on the exam calendar.	Book exam on-demand 24/7.
Exam results typically available within one to two business days	Exam results typically available within one to two business days.

Options available to students <u>currently</u> enrolled in all INSURANCE program courses.

- 1. **Starting** January 23, 2023, students have the option switch to the new Program with modular online proctored exams by calling us at 1-888-865-2437 or emailing ifse@ifse.ca.
- 2. Students who wish to stay in the current program must successfully complete the single online proctored exam no later than February 28, 2023. If students do not complete the exam by this date, they will automatically be enrolled in the new Program with modular online proctored exams.
- 3. To help make the transition easier, we're granting all existing students an extension, so they will have **one full year** from the time the switch is made to complete their modular online proctored exams.



Reminder: Students will not be affected by these changes if they complete their course in the current Program (including successfully completing the prerequisite learning activities and single online proctored exam) before the changes take effect February 28, 2023.
